Court/ Tribunal/Agency where litigation is filed	Allahabad High Court
Brief details of dispute/litigation	The Writ Petition is filed against the orders dated 21.07.2018, 15.02.2021, 12.07.2021, 21.09.2021, 09.05.2022, 11.10.2022, 07.11.2022 and 04.01.2023 in Adjudication Case No. 555/2018 passed by the Respondent No. 3 (Presiding Officer, Labour Court, G. B. Nagar) and notice dated 19.07.2023 issued by Respondent No. 6 and 7 (District Magistrate/ District Collector, G.B. Nagar and Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Dadri respectively) attaching the bank account of the Petitioner in Central Bank of India, Sector 63, Noida. By way of the Impugned Orders, the Respondent No. 3 has purportedly adjudicated upon Adjudication Case No. 555/2018 and erroneously accepted the claims of the Respondent No. 1 (Dinesh Chandra Sharma) under the Working Journalists, and Other Newspaper Employees (Conditions of Service) and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1955. Hence, the Writ Petition.

Brief details of dispute/litigation	The instant review application is filed against the Judgment dated 27.04.2023 in Writ-C No. 23212 of 2021 and Writ-C No.10419 of 2023. By way of the Impugned Judgement, the Writ Petitions were dismissed with cost of INR 25,000/-. The Writ Petition 10419 of 2023 arises from the proceedings before the Labour Commissioner, G.B Nagar in Adjudication Case No. 678 of 2018. The Applicant also preferred another Writ Petition being Writ – C No. 23212 of 2021 in relation to a separate set of proceedings being Adjudication No. 584 of 2018. The review application was listed for hearing on 11.08.2023. The Court has reserved the order in the said review application.
